

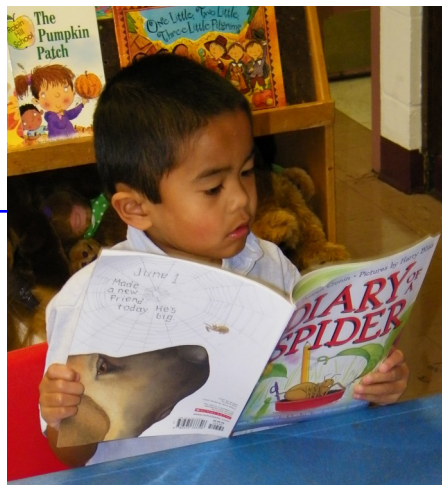

Classes are led by certified teachers.

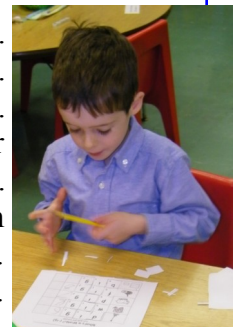
Each classroom is assisted by an aide.

## **Religious Education**

- Christ is the heart of our school. Kindergarten students are brought to the Lord through prayer and scripture daily. Mass is celebrated in the Chapel of St. Clare at Holy Trinity Catholic School weekly. Kindergarten students lead the school in prayer to celebrate the birth of Jesus and to celebrate the close of the school year. All children are encouraged through example to be servants in their community and witnesses of their faith.

## **Language Arts**

- Kindergarten students learn to identify letters, blend sounds, decode sounds to read words, produce rhyming words and read sight words. They will practice the correct formation of letters and numbers and learn to use the writing line. Kindergarten students will use developmental spelling to construct words and be able to correctly write a sentence.

## **Math**

- Kindergarten students will recognize and extend patterns, count and identify numbers to 100, write dictated numbers, demonstrate the concept of addition and subtraction with manipulatives, tell time to the hour and identify coins and their values.

## **Co-Curricular**

- Kindergarten students participate in art, music, physical education, computer, library and Spanish throughout the week.

## **Extra-Curricular**

- Kindergarten students are invited to join Young Authors, Chess Club and Scouts.

## **School Hours**

- 8:30 a.m.-3 p.m.; Before and After-Care are available on-site.

## **Uniforms**

- Holy Trinity Catholic School students wear uniforms available at local department stores and The Dwelling Place.

**Tuition 2012-13:** Tuition for members of Holy Trinity Church and St. Patrick Church of Merna is \$4,300 for the first student, \$3,200 for the second student, \$1,900 for the third student. For the fourth or more students in a family, tuition is \$500 per student. Non-affiliated members are charged \$6,100 per student. The cost of education is in excess of \$6,100 per student.

A family commitment fee of \$300 is due at time of registration. The commitment fee, per family, is deducted from the total family tuition. Families have the option of paying more than the required minimum \$300 to reduce monthly payments.
